Learning Sequence			
	Substantive knowledge	Disciplinary knowledge objective	Activity
1	To understand that different fabrics can be used for different things.	I can describe different fabrics.	Explore a range of puppets and discuss what they are made from, how they move. Develop a class criteria for a puppet – a puppet should... Look at different fabrics in groups and discuss what fabric is used for. Identify which fabrics would be suitable to make a puppet.
2	To know how to join fabrics in different ways.	I can select an appropriate way to join my fabric.	Explain their D&T project is a pop up puppet. Model different ways fabric can be joined (glue –FS2) stapled and sewing using binca or hessian. Practise ways to join different fabric.
3	To know how to present a design.	I can draw a simple design for my pop up puppet.	Model how to show the design. Develop a list to support labelling. Children to draw own design of an owl or rabbit from Kippers Toybox and add details labels.
4	To know how to use their ideas to make a mock up	I can develop a mock-up of what my puppet will look like.	Introduce new vocab (mock up) Use different materials and joining techniques to develop a mock up following own design.
5	To know how to join fabric.	I can use joining techniques to make my puppet.	Use template to draw and cut out shapes for parts of the puppet. Join together using chosen technique.
6	To know how to evaluate my design.	I can say what went well and what didn't work well.	Discuss what worked well during the process and what didn't work well. T scribe responses.
