1	Vincent Van Gogh was a Dutch artist who painted portraits and still life		Show children Van Gogh portraits- can they remember these from last year? Explain Van Gogh also painted lots of pictures of the objects around him- these are known as a still life. Watch episode of StoryZoo Van Gogh museum
2	Vincent Van Gogh used oil paint, brushes and palette knives to make his pictures.  He is famous for using bright colours and bold brush strokes in his work	Find out about different types of paint and mark-making implements.	Look at 'Sunflowers' painting- how has the paint been applied?- Is the paint thick/thin do you think he used a large/fine brush etc Explore using ready mix paint with a range of mark making tools (thick and thin brushes, palette knife)
3	The names of primary colours.  The names of secondary colours and can mix them.	Mix a range of secondary colour shades using powder paint noticing how the different types of primary colours affect the outcome.	Practice colour mixing different shades of green, orange and purple
