<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Neil Armstrong was an American astronaut. Neil was chosen to be commander of the Apollo 11 mission to the moon in 1969. He was the first person to walk on the moon. He famously said ‘one small step for man, one giant leap for mankind’. The spacecraft launched from the Kennedy Space Centre in Florida. He got his pilots licence at the age of sixteen and flew in the Navy.
