In school this week children in:

FS2 have been:

- ❖ Building simple story maps in literacy
- ❖ Comparing amounts of objects in maths
- ❖ Drawn the people who live in our house and named them and have also started to paint our self portraits

Year 1 have:

- ❖ Introduced the story 'Peace at Last' and matched captions to pictures using our phonic knowledge to decode and read the words in English
- ❖ Represented numbers 0-10 in different ways in maths
- ❖ Colour mixed shades of orange in art
- ❖ Identified landmarks on our journey to school in geography
- ❖ Discussed the story of 'Noah's Ark' in RE

Year 2 have:

- ❖ Introduced a new story called 'On the way home', we have used actions to retell the story and practiced writing simple sentences to match a picture.
- ❖ Looked at 10s and 1s on a number line and added the missing numbers in maths
- ❖ Been looking at human and physical geographical features of Warsop in geography
- ❖ Used the colour white to change blue on a colour wheel in art
- ❖ Been practising our balancing skills in PE
