#### **FS2 have been:**

- o Identifying the initial sound in words
- o Comparing mass, capacity and size in maths
- o Working on our self portraits
- o Talking about the jobs people do

#### **Year 1 have:**

- o Written labels using our phonic knowledge in English
- o Counted backwards from 10 and found 1 less in maths
- o Colour mixed shades of purple in art
- o Identified similarities and differences of the key features of plants in science
- o Made a map of the layout of school in geography

#### **Year 2 have:**

- o Writing words in the past tense and continuing using a story map and actions for Talk for Write
- o Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s from any given number to extend the sequence
- o Adding black to the colour blue to alter its tint
- o Finding out about Saint Peter and why he was a good leader in RE
- o Exploring jumping, hopping and skipping actions in PE
- o Planting seeds and bulbs and have made a prediction as to which they think will grow quicker over time
