

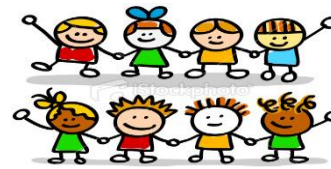

In school this week children in:

FS2 have:

- ❖ Enjoyed listening to the story of *Oliver's Vegetables* and in literacy have been using their phonic knowledge to read CVC words
- ❖ Investigated measure and pattern in maths
- ❖ Used pastel to add features to our self-portraits in art
- ❖ Labelled areas of our school

Year 1 have:

- ❖ Written captions to match the picture in English
- ❖ Compared numbers using < > and = in maths
- ❖ Created a variety of art inspired by Van Gogh sunflowers using different media
- ❖ Sorted physical and human features of Warsop in geography
- ❖ Discussed what is a good bedtime routine

Year 2 have been:

- ❖ Learning to use punctuation accurately and to identify different sentences when retelling a familiar story.
- ❖ Adding a single digit number to a two digit number.
- ❖ Finding out about Vincent Van Gogh and exploring the Painting 'Starry Night.'
- ❖ Learning about the Christian festival of Harvest and the Jewish festival Sukkot.
- ❖ Developing coordination and combining jumps.
- ❖ Observing their planted seeds and bulbs and completed a diary to show how much they have grown.
