We hope you had a good half term

In school this week children in:

FS2 have:

- Been looking at the story of 'Mrs Wishy Washy' and identified the sounds in words during our Literacy time.
- Explored the numbers 1, 2 and 3 in Maths
- Found out about bonfire night and how to stay safe.

Year 1 have:

- Drawn a story map to help retell 'The Smartest Giant in Town' in literacy.
- Been developing their addition skills.
- Identified what material an object is made from in Science
- Investigated joining techniques as part of this terms D & T project.
