Thank you for your support with our colour work over the last few weeks. We have enjoyed sharing what the children have made at home.

This week we will be starting a new book "Tap the Magic Tree" which follows the changes to a tree through the different seasons. We will be exploring the colour **green**, talking about the green leaves on the tree and how we can mix blue and yellow to make green.

We will also be looking at apples and sorting and making patterns using red and green. It would be great this week if you could help your child to spot things that are green at home and on the way to and from school.
