Nursery (FS1) News

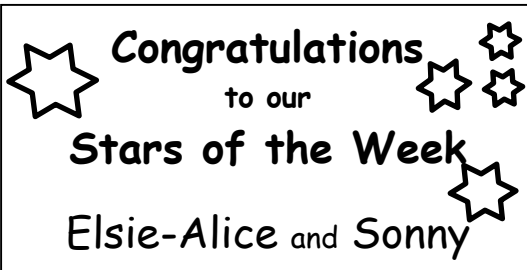
